

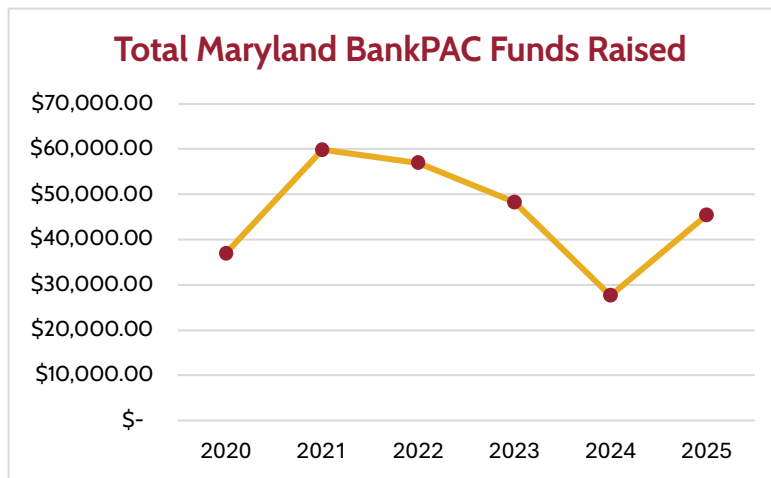


2025 ANNUAL REPORT
